### Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) Program Application Checklist Application Deadline: January 5, 2010

All applicants are required to submit the following items to make their application complete:

- PharmCAS application must be submitted online prior to the deadline (<http://www.pharmcas.org>). All U.S. college transcripts and PCAT scores must be sent to PharmCAS.
- Letters of Reference must be submitted to PharmCAS. You will include the information for each person writing a letter on your behalf and will indicate whether they will be submitting an electronic or paper letter of reference.
- Supplemental Application must be submitted online prior to the deadline. (<http://cophs.mercer.edu/SupplementalApplication.shtm>)
- Supplemental Application fee (\$25) must be submitted to our office prior to the deadline. Check or money order made out to Mercer University can be sent to the address below. This fee is non-refundable. The College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences does not issue refunds for application withdrawals or missed deadlines. *Please make sure you include your name and PharmCAS ID number on your check or money order.* Note: A recent photo is no longer required.
- Pharmacy College Admissions Test (PCAT) Scores. PCAT scores must be submitted to PharmCAS (use code 104), and must be received before your file can be considered complete and ready for review. Only scores from June 2005 to January 2010 will be accepted in the current admissions cycle.
